Some Quick Reminders!



Avoid Collections - Unpaid January Assessments are quickly approaching being 90 days delinquent. If you have not paid your Assessments in full please do so quickly. Avoid collections by making a payment online or in the office. If you have any questions regarding making a payment, please see me at the office.



Yard Violations - Now that the weather is finally warming up, it's important to get our yards looking great again. **Dry Grass and Dead Plant Violations will start on April 1.** Remember grass must be green and healthy, any plants or shrubs must be trimmed neatly, and any dead plants must be removed.



Keycards for Amenity Center Access - Just a reminder that to use the Pool, Basketball Court, and/or Playground, you must have a working keycard on hand to open the gates. No one will be permitted inside without a working keycard. Anyone who lets someone in without a keycard takes responsibility for any damages or rule-breaking that person may do, which could result in keycard suspension and/or fines.
