WHY YOU CAN'T HAVE GLASS NEAR A POOL -


THIS IS ACTUALLY A CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT RULE. ANY GLASS FOUND NEAR A POOL WILL TEMPORARILY CLOSE THE POOL UNITL THE GLASS CAN BE COMPLETELY REMOVED.

ONCE GLASS FALLS IN A POOL IT
BECOMES VIRTUALLY INVISIBLE. THIS
MAKES IT VERY DIFFICULT TO CLEAN AND
ENSURE THAT EVERY GLASS PIECE HAS
BEEN COLLECTED. SWIMMERS CAN GET
CUT OR EVEN INGEST GLASS WHILE
SWIMMING IF SHARDS ARE STILL IN THE
POOL.

WE TAKE THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ANYONE ENJOYING THE AMENITY CENTER VERY SERIOUSLY. THE PROCESS IS NOT A QUICK FIX BUT THE POOL WILL BE OPEN ONCE IT IS SAFE TO DO SO. WE APPRECIATE EVERYONE'S PAITIENCE WHILE WE GET THIS FIXED.

Exterior Modifications - Any modifications made to the exterior of the home - front, back, where ever, must be approved by the ARB Committee. This includes paint, roof, patio, pavers, room additions, and more. Doing an exterior modification without approval could result in fines and having to remove/change the modification.

Any waste is also your responsibility to clean up.
