## WHY YOU CAN'T HAVE GLASS NEAR A POOL -

THIS IS ACTUALLY A CITY HEALTH
DEPARTMENT RULE. ANY GLASS FOUND
NEAR A POOL WILL TEMPORARILY CLOSE
THE POOL UNITL THE GLASS CAN BE
COMPLETELY REMOVED.

ONCE GLASS FALLS IN A POOL IT
BECOMES VIRTUALLY INVISIBLE. THIS
MAKES IT VERY DIFFICULT TO CLEAN AND
ENSURE THAT EVERY GLASS PIECE HAS
BEEN COLLECTED. SWIMMERS CAN GET
CUT OR EVEN INGEST GLASS WHILE
SWIMMING IF SHARDS ARE STILL IN THE
POOL.

WE TAKE THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ANYONE ENJOYING THE AMENITY CENTER VERY SERIOUSLY. THE PROCESS IS NOT A QUICK FIX SO PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU DON'T BRING ANY GLASS TO THE POOL!

### Some Quick Reminders!



Proper Swimwear - Now is the perfect time to swim. Please keep in mind that the proper swimwear must be worn while in the water. T-Shirts, Jeans, etc are not permitted. This can cause issues with our filters and could result in the pool having to be shut down. Bathing Suits are made of a special material that prevents shedding in water.



Exterior Modifications - Any modifications made to the exterior of the home - front, back, where ever, must be approved by the ARB Committee. This includes paint, roof, patio, pavers, room additions, and more. Doing an exterior modification without approval could result in fines and having to remove/change the modification.



Parking on Grass - Per the Covenants and Restrictions, vehicles cannot be parked on your properties grass, even if it's just two tires. This could ruin the grass. Please make sure you are only parking in your garage or on your driveway. If you do park in the streets, please make sure you are following all City Ordinances to avoid a ticket/City Towing.
